Moisture continues to hamper planting and haying. A few guys have managed to sneak in and get some work done but overall, just not enough days without a shower in the forecast for most to get to rolling. Those wrapping higher moisture hay have been able to get some done but very little dry hay has gone up at this point. Moisture continues to improve the drought monitor as of the current publication 82 percent of the state is now drought free. One county in SW is still mostly listed as abnormally dry but other than that the remaining in 18 percent is far south central and all of the southeast corner. The supply of hay is light to moderate; demand light and prices are steady to weak.
