Compared to last week hay sold steady on thin test of the market. Demand remains light. Quite a few producers are green chopping there first cutting alfalfa and its going to dairies or feedlots. Tonnage reports vary from field to field in all areas. Some reports of 2 tons plus per acre. On fields with weevils that has not been sprayed around 1 to 1.50 tons per acre. Spotty rain showers across most of the state. However, along the boarder of Wyoming and Nebraska abnormally dry conditions are prevailing. Per NASS: Corn planting is at 91% completed and 61% emerged. Soybeans are 80% planted compared to 87% last year with only 41% emerged. Dry edible beans are 10% planted the same as most years.
