## National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance - Domestic Market Highlights

Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady for both whole birds and WOGS. Supplies are moderate. Demand is moderate entering the weekend. Processing schedules are normal to less than normal. Floor stocks are balanced. Market activity is light to moderate. In the parts structure, prices of b/s breasts and tenders are trending firm. Steady to firm for wings and dark meat cuts. Steady for fronts and bone-in breasts. Supplies of tenders are short of needs. B/S breasts are tight to instances short; light to moderate for wings and dark meat cuts, moderate for fronts and bone-in breasts. Thighs and thigh meat are seasonally light. Demand is moderate. Market activity is moderate. In production areas, live supplies are available. Weights are less than desirable



# Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 2 Percent

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 190 million chicks for meat production during the week ending May 4, 2024, up 2 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 6, 2024 through May 4, 2024 for the United States were 3.38 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.
