The Central and East dry buttermilk price series inched higher at the bottom of the range. Cream remains available in both regions for the time being, and butter production schedules are in line with recent weeks. Contacts anticipate dry buttermilk production schedules to shift down in gear as components tighten in the coming weeks. Condensed buttermilk remains available, and drying activity is steady. Contacts share dry buttermilk demand is starting to pick up as Q3 approaches. Spot loads are available for end users.
