The Central and East dry buttermilk price range moved lower at both ends. Cream remains available in the Central region, but Eastern contacts note cream supplies are tightening. Butter processors share churning schedules are in line with recent weeks. Liquid buttermilk supplies remain strong, and drying activity is matching the rate of production. Contacts have shared mixed notes on spot availability, which are more available in certain areas due to continued strong churning and drying activity. Domestic demand is steady.
