1. PURPOSE

This Directive transmits the fee schedule and billing codes for official services performed by the Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS), Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS), under the United States Grain Standards Act (USGSA), and the Agricultural Marketing Act (AMA) of 1946.

2. REPLACEMENT HIGHLIGHTS

This directive revises the fee schedule for grain inspection per Federal Register (89 FR 16521), dated March 7, 2024, with changes effective April 1, 2024. Additionally, this directive removes rice inspection billing code R7ELEM for lab testing service and adds footnote explanation for travel and related expenses on attachment 1 table 3 miscellaneous services and updates footnote 1 on attachment 3 for travel and related expenses.

This Directive supersedes FGIS Directive 9180.74, dated October 1, 2023.

3. AUTHORITIES

The United States Grain Standards Act, as amended

The Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946

Title 7, Code of Federal Regulations, Parts 800 and 868

4. POLICY

Fees assessed by FGIS for official services shall be reasonable, nondiscriminatory, and cover the estimated cost of the service. These costs include direct, administrative, and supervisory costs related to these services.
