Compared to last sale(4-22-24): Feeder lambs were not well tested this sale as most lambs were purchased for slaughter. Slaughter lambs sold mostly 10.00-20.00 lower on all classes. All lambs in the report below are new crop lambs unless tagged as old crop. Many lambs on offer were short docked, heavy muscled blackface lambs. Lambs over 75 lbs sold with better demand than their lighter weight counterparts as these lambs offered higher yielding carcasses for slaughter buyers. Several ethnic buyers were present again this sale and lambs were purchased for slaughter in several states across the country. Quality was mostly average to attractive for slaughter buyers as many lambs were bloomy and offered average to above average yields. Market activity was mostly active with serval ethnic buyers bidding on offerings. Demand for slaughter ewes was mostly light to moderate. The best demand was for Good (fleshy) ewes. Good slaughter ewes sold 3.00-5.00 lower. Utility and cull ewes sold 5.00-8.00 lower. Several packages of ewes were purchased to feed this sale as demand for medium and thin flesh ewes was significantly lower than fleshy ewes. Slaughter kids sold 5.00 to 10.00 higher. Demand for goats was mostly good. Goat quality was mostly plain to average this sale and lower compared to last sale. Demand for goats under 50 lbs was light and most of these offerings sold to feeding buyers. Feeding goats sold sharply lower as quality and seasonality affected demand. Goats seasonally float lower in price during the summer months and buyers showed lighter demand as a result. Supply included: 11% Feeder Sheep/Lambs (6% Lambs, 94% Sheep); 66% Slaughter Sheep/Lambs (50% Wooled & Shorn, 6% Hair Breeds, 38% Ewes, 4% Hair Ewes, 3% Bucks, 0% Hair Bucks); 2% Replacement Sheep/Lambs (19% Ewes, 46% Families, 35% Bucks); 4% Feeder Goats (100% Kids); 16% Slaughter Goats (68% Kids, 24% Nannies/Does, 4% Bucks/Billies, 4% Wethers).
