Compared to last week hay sales are steady southern and western part of the state having their 1st cut down and baled demand is good. Alfalfa Hay for the 1st cutting is 54% complete, southern part of the state are 1% into their 2nd cutting. According to National Agricultural Statistics Service New Mexico field office May 12, 2024, Hay and roughage supplies were reported as 40 percent very short, 53 percent short, and 7 percent adequate, compared with 32 percent very short, 58 percent short, and 10 percent adequate last week. Stock water supplies were reported as 64 percent very short, 23 percent short, and 13 percent adequate, compared with 56 percent very short, 27 percent short, 16 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus last week.

Prices are dollars per ton and FOB they field or hay barn unless otherwise noted.
