New York eggs are unchanged for Extra Large, Large, and Medium. California and regional prices are 8 cents lower for Jumbo, down 9 to 29 cents for Extra Large, down 4.5 to 33 cents for Large, 4.5 to 28 cents lower for Medium, and down 8 cents for Small. The undertone is steady to weak. Demand is light to moderate. Offerings are light to moderate. Supplies are moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock supplies are moderate; breaking schedules are full-time to reduced. Spent fowl supplies are at least moderate for the light demand.


