



Export Requirements for Further Processed Egg Products containing only egg – Mexico

Eligible/Ineligible Products

- A. Eligible Product
 - a. Further Processed Egg Products

- B. Ineligible Product
 - a. Product with specific state restrictions –

Documentation Requirements

- A. Prior to processing, plant management is responsible for establishing detailed written procedures/records to provide the traceability system and procedures to maintain the identity of the product from the time of production through transport, storage, processing and packaging.
- B. Plant Management is responsible for maintaining all applicable records for one year.
- C. AMS verification audit and the products identified by country of destination updated on the AMS website.
- D. The product reached one of the following internal temperatures and cooking times 60.0 °C for 10 minutes, pasteurization, or commercial sterilization.
- E. Obtain AMS Form *Further Processed Egg and Egg Foods Export Certificate*.

Handling/Storage Requirements

- A. Transport containers used to ship product to Mexico must be clean.
- B. The transport container(s) must be sealed (Company seal) prior to departure from the processing facility. The seal number must be recorded on the *Further Processed Egg and Egg Foods Export Certificate*
