FILE MAINTENANCE ON APPLICATIONS FOR MEAT GRADING AND CERTIFICATION SERVICES AND COMMITMENT AGREEMENTS

Effective immediately, retain the office copies of form LS-313, Application for Service, and form LS-315, Application for Commitment Grading or Certification Service, for a period of ten (10) years from the date service was last provided or from the date the application was canceled or becomes invalid. The Office of the General Counsel has requested that we extend the retention periods for legal purposes.
