OFFER TO BUY: Canned Fruit, Vegetables, and Dry Beans

Department of Agriculture announced it is planning to purchase canned fruit, vegetables, and dry beans for distribution to the Disaster Feeding Program, the Child Nutrition Program and the Needy Family Program according to Robert C. Keeney, Deputy Administrator, Fruit and Vegetable Programs, Agricultural Marketing Service.

The anticipated purchases will be made from offers that must be submitted on a delivered-to-destination price basis. Deliveries will be required during the period of July 1, 2007 through September 30, 2007.
