

Specifically, can you feed beef animals corn raised by standard means (fertilizer (19-19-19), and herbicides) and still have it considered organic product?

No. The producer of an organic livestock operation must provide livestock with a total feed ration composed of agricultural products, including pasture and forage, that are organically produced and, if applicable, organically handled: Except, That, nonsynthetic substances and synthetic substances allowed under § 205.603 may be used as feed additives and supplements. Ref: § 205.237 Livestock feed.
