

Can a coffee drink with the following ingredients (71.45% Water, 4.5% Organic Sugar, 22.65% Organic Coffee Bean Extract, 1.0 % Whole Milk Powder, 0.3% Natural Coffee Flavor, 0.10% Emulsifier) be labeled as organic?

No, it cannot. By weight of the ingredients, it could. However, you have whole milk powder that is not organic in your product. In order to label your product as organic, this agricultural ingredient must be organic.
