

What can you apply to organic seed without losing its organic status?

Substances included on the National List of synthetic substances allowed for use in organic crop production may be used to produce an organic crop when an equivalent organically produced or untreated variety is not commercially available. Ref: § 205.204(a)(2)

Seeds, annual seedlings, and planting stock treated with prohibited substances may be used to produce an organic crop when the application of the materials is a requirement of Federal or State phytosanitary regulations. Ref: § 205.204(a)(5).
