

Can packaged produce like onions and potatoes be displayed together (touching) even though their packaging contains holes (plastic bags or mesh bags), or do they have to be physically separated? If so, what is the allowed minimum distance?

There are no specified minimum distances required between organic and nonorganic bulk produce in the NOP regulations. However, there must be sufficient measures taken (packaging, distance, physical barriers) to prevent commingling and contamination between organic and conventional produce.
