

Except for the use in lye peeling of all other fruits and vegetables besides IAF peaches, are we reading § 205.605(b) correctly if we allow the use of potassium hydroxide in products labeled as 'organic?' Does § 205.105(a) apply here?

Potassium hydroxide is allowed under 205.605 (b) in organic foods. It is prohibited in lye-peeling of fruits and vegetables.
