

Do carriers of livestock feed minerals have to be certified organic?

According to the NOP regulations, all feed fed to livestock must be either 100% organic or organic. Feed may also contain feed additives and supplements, and those additives and supplements may be non-agricultural, non-synthetic (e.g., natural) substances, or they may be approved synthetic substances that appear on the National List under 205.603.

Regardless of the content, all feed, feed additive, and feed supplements must comply with the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FFDCA), as stated under 205.237 (b)(6).
