

**According to 205.601.m.1 Inerts in List 4 “Inerts of minimal concern” can be used as ingredients in pesticides. I understand from the regulation that amounts of the approved inerts are not regulated, and that means that an inert listed in list 4 A or B can be used in the amounts the company formulating the product considers necessary, am I right?**

Only List 4 Inerts, posted as of August 2004, may be used without review in pesticides with approved active ingredients (substances) that appear on the National List on 205.601. All other inerts must be petitioned to the NOSB for inclusion on the National List, since EPA ceased maintenance of the List of Inerts.
