

## Summary of Potato Import Requirements

Type	Minimum Regulatory Provisions
<b>Long type</b>	<p><b>Grade</b> – U.S. No. 2 grade.</p> <p><b>Size</b> – 2 inches or 4 ounces. Provided that 40% are 5 ounces or heavier. May be size B or Creamer if otherwise U.S. No. 1 grade.</p> <p><b>Cleanness</b> – “fairly clean.”</p> <p><b>Maturity</b> – “slightly skinned.”</p>
<b>Red-skinned, round type</b>	<p><b>Grade</b> – U.S. No. 2 grade.</p> <p><b>Size</b> – 1 7/8 inches, may be 3/4 inch if otherwise U.S. No. 1 grade.</p> <p><b>Cleanness</b> – as listed in U.S. Potato Standards.</p> <p><b>Maturity</b> – “moderately skinned.”</p>
<b>All other round type</b>	<p><b>Grade</b> – U.S. No. 2 grade.</p> <p><b>Size</b> – 2 inches. May be size B or 1 inch to 1 3/4 inches if otherwise U.S. Commercial grade.</p> <p><b>Maturity</b> – in effect August 1 to October 31. For U.S. No. 2 grade, “moderately skinned”, and for all other grades, “slightly skinned.”</p>
<b>Exemptions</b>	No size requirements for potatoes imported in containers with a net weight of 3 pounds or less, if potatoes are otherwise U.S. No. 1 grade or better.
