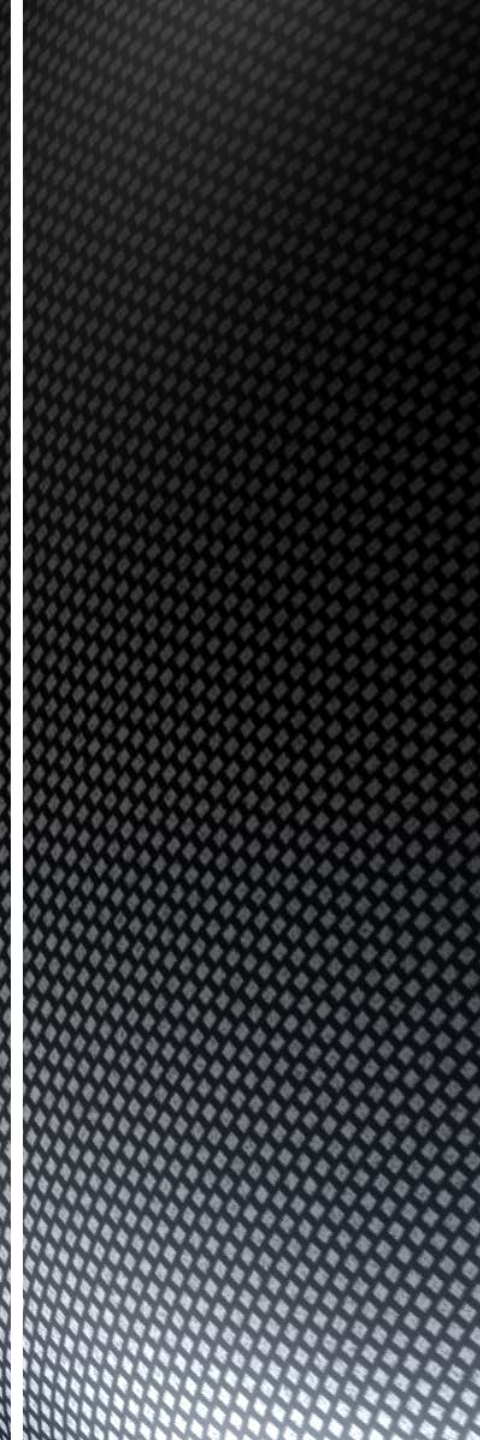

ITEM DESCRIPTION AND CHECKLIST OF REQUIREMENTS (IDCR) FOR ALASKA POLLOCK BLOCKS-JANUARY 2013

- Update metal detection requirements and delivery unit sealing requirements - specification uniformity
- Web Based Supply Chain Management (WBSCM) Format Changes
 - Announcement changed to Supplement
 - Contract Number changed to Purchase Order Number
 - FNS Product Codes changed to Material Numbers



IDCR FOR CATFISH STRIPS, BREADED, OVEN-READY - AUGUST 2012

- Added 5 pound packaging option and new material number to reflect new package size



IDCR FOR CANNED BEEF AND PORK IN JUICES – JULY 2012

- Added provision for allowing use of frozen meat
- Objectionable materials list updated – specification uniformity
- LFTB not allowed
- Labeling Uniformity – Nutrition Facts Panel on Immediate Container
- WBSCM Format Changes
 - Announcement changed to Supplement
 - Contract Number changed to Purchase Order Number
 - FNS Product Codes changed to Material Numbers



IDCR FOR CANNED BEEF STEW, CANNED BISON STEW AND CANNED CHILI WITHOUT BEANS– JULY 2012

- Provision added to allow use of frozen meat
- LFTB not allowed
- Added Domestic Origin requirement for vegetables and other significant ingredients
- MSG not allowed
- Labeling Uniformity – Added USDA Shield, nutrition facts panel and allergen statement
- Updated Objectionable Materials list
- WBSCM Format Changes
 - Announcement changed to Supplement
 - Contract Number changed to Purchase Order Number
 - FNS Product Codes changed to Material Numbers



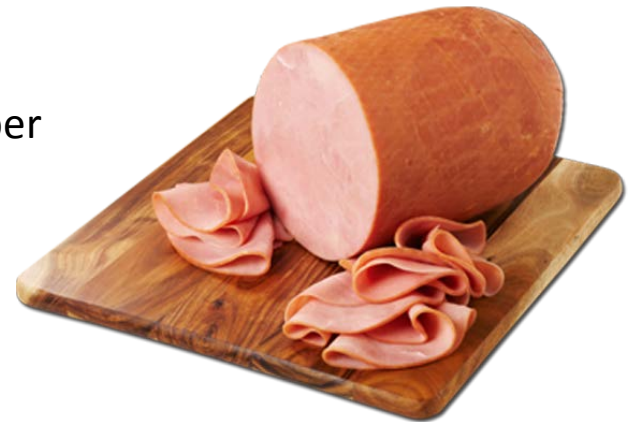
IDCR FOR FULLY COOKED, THINLY SLICED ROAST BEEF – JUNE 2012

- Labeling Uniformity – Allergen Statement
- WBSCM Format Changes
 - Announcement changed to Supplement
 - Contract Number changed to Purchase Order Number
 - FNS Product Codes changed to Material Numbers



IDCR FOR HAM PRODUCTS – SEPTEMBER 2012

- Added sow carcasses as acceptable source of raw materials
- Specification uniformity – added traceability of raw material requirement, shipping container closure requirement and Domestic Origin requirement for significant ingredients
- Included minus 60 pound tolerance for 3 pound ham delivery unit
- Labeling uniformity – added Allergen Statement
- WBSCM Format Changes
 - Announcement changed to Supplement
 - Contract Number changed to Purchase Order Number
 - FNS Product Codes changed to Material Numbers



IDCR FOR BEEF SPECIAL TRIM – JUNE 2012

- Specification uniformity – added Warranty and Complaint Resolution requirements
- Labeling uniformity – Added Nutrition Facts Panel, Ingredient Declaration and Allergen Statement
- WBSCM Format Changes
 - Announcement changed to Supplement
 - Contract Number changed to Purchase Order Number
 - FNS Product Codes changed to Material Numbers



IDCR FOR DICED BEEF – JANUARY 2013

- Added provision to allow use of frozen beef
- Added metal detection requirements



IDCR FOR BEEF ROUND ROASTS, BONELESS – JANUARY 2013

- Specification uniformity – Updated pathogen intervention and carcass testing requirements
- Included minus 60 pound tolerance for delivery unit
- Labeling uniformity – Added Nutrition Facts Panel, Ingredient Declaration and Allergen Statement
- WBSCM Format Changes
 - Announcement changed to Supplement
 - Contract Number changed to Purchase Order Number
 - FNS Product Codes changed to Material Numbers



IDCR FOR COOKED BEEF AND COOKED PORK ITEMS – JANUARY 2013

- Added 2 pound package option
- Specification uniformity – updated shipping container closure requirements
- Added two new portion sizes for Beef Patties with SPP (1.7 and 2.2 ounces) and new corresponding material numbers to accommodate FNS MMA requirements



Technical Data Supplement (TDS) for Lamb Leg Roasts and Shoulder Chops – May 2012

- Specification uniformity – Added Domestic Origin and Humane Handling requirements
- Included provision to allow leaving Rib Bones and Sternum on shoulder chops
- Leg Roast weight range changed to 3-8 pounds
- Labeling uniformity – Added Safe Handling Instructions, Ingredient Declaration and Allergen Statement
- Specification uniformity - Added Contractor Checkloading requirements and included minus 60 pound tolerance for delivery unit
