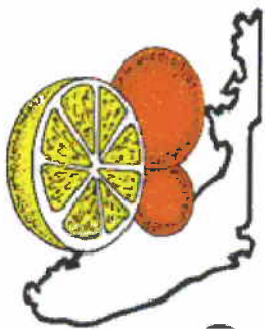

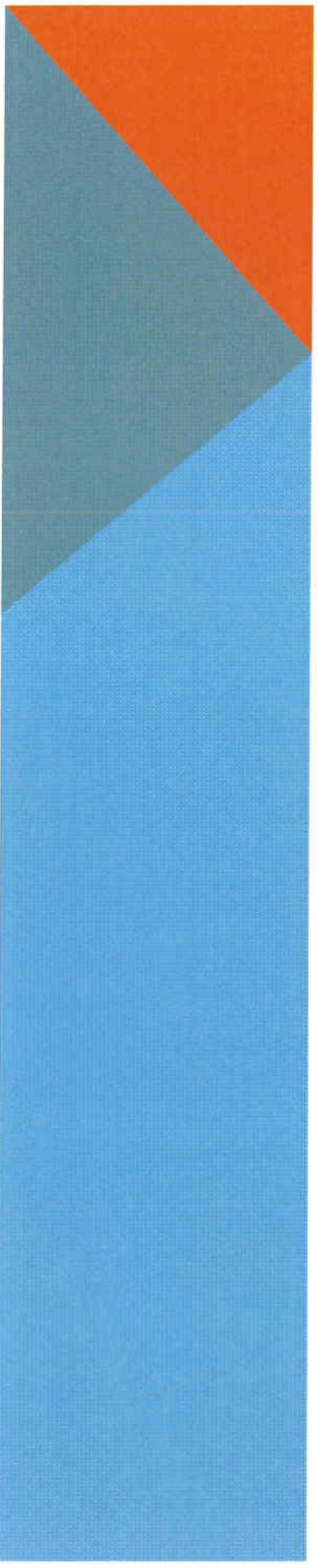

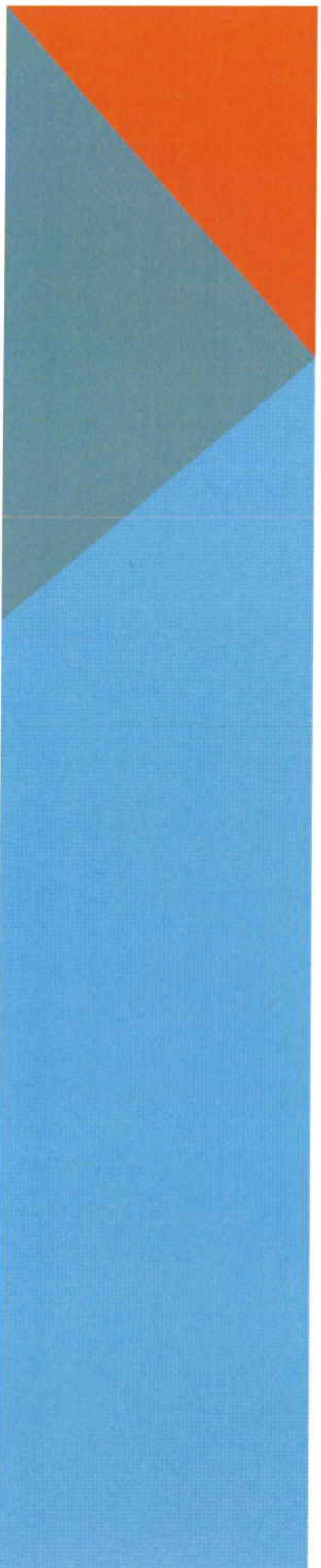
BENEFITS TO COMMITTEE

SHIPPER REGISTRATION

- Completed by Shipper
- Must have Florida Citrus Fruit Dealer's License
- Contact Information
 - Physical Address
 - Billing Address
- Approved by Manager for the Committee
- Committee Post Approves Manager's Approval



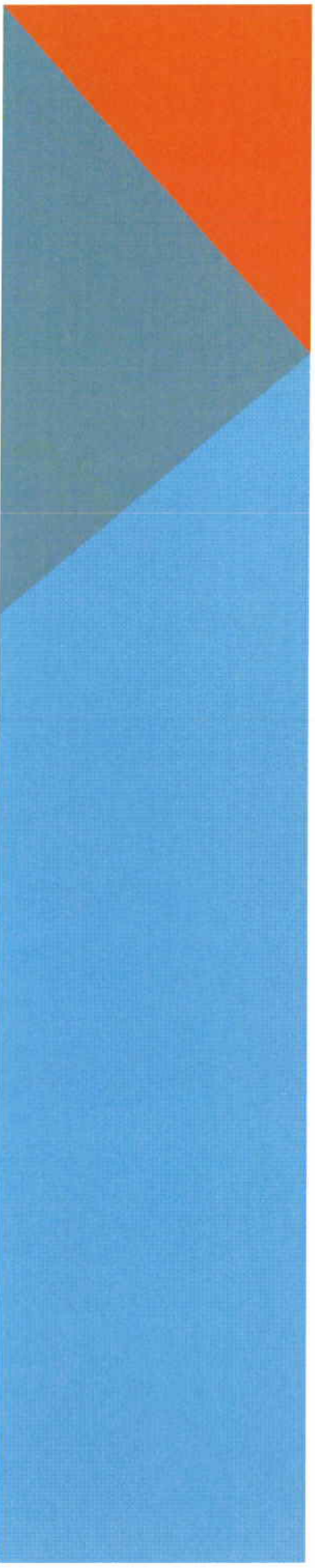
FRESH SHIPMENTS TIME FRAME

- Fresh Shipments begin in late September to early October
- 95% of Fresh Shipments -- October thru April
- The majority of shippers have completed shipments by late April
- 5% of Fresh Shipments -- April thru June
- 60 to 150 days between seasons



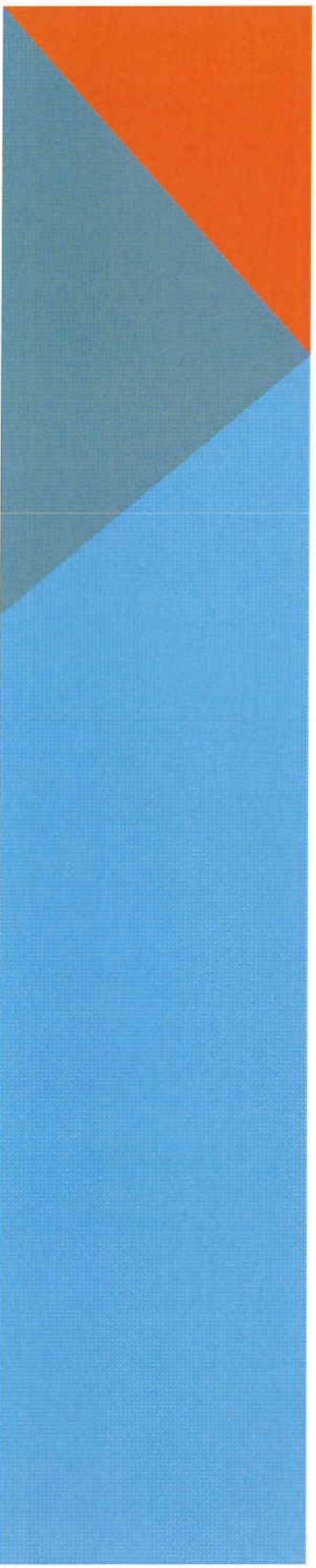
DUE PROCESS FOR SHIPPERS

- Internal Control Policies reviewed and approved annually
 - Invoicing Policies
- Each season the Committee reviews and submits the CAC Compliance Plan to the Secretary for approval
 - The Compliance Plan outlines time frames for the collection of assessments
 - Payments due 30 days after invoice date
 - First Past Due Notice – mailed – 30 days
 - Second Past Due Notice – certified mail – 40 days
