**NATIONAL ORGANIC STANDARDS BOARD
FINAL RECOMMENDATION ADDENDUM NUMBER 8
ORGANIC LIVESTOCK HEALTHCARE PRACTICES**

Date adopted: April 25, 1995
Location: Orlando, Florida

The following additions are to be inserted in the Organic Livestock Healthcare Practices section, page 10, line 278 of the NOSB Final Recommendations adopted June 1-4, 1994 in Santa Fe, New Mexico.

Certified organic livestock farms shall be based on a system that incorporates access to the outdoors and direct sunlight.

It is understood that proper livestock health management may include periods of time when livestock are housed indoors. Temporary indoor housing may be justified for:

1. inclement weather conditions;
2. health, care, safety, and well being of the livestock; and
3. protection of soil and water quality.
