Production of cotton linters by United States oil mills totaled 55,000 running bale equivalents during August (four weeks), according to the Bureau of the Census. This was up from 43,000 bales produced last year and 50,000 bales produced two years ago. Shipments of cotton linters from oil mills totaled 58,000 bales in August, up from 44,000 last year and 49,000 bales in August 2002.

Consumption of cotton linters by domestic mills totaled 48,000 bales during August (four weeks). This was up from 45,000 bales consumed in last year and 47,000 bales two years ago. The number of bales used by domestic bleachers in August was withheld to avoid disclosing data for individual companies. Consumers other than bleachers used 2,000 bales in August. This was up from 1,000 bales used last year and two years ago.

Stocks of cotton linters totaled 101,000 bales at the end of August. This was down from 142,000 bales in August a year earlier and 163,000 bales two years ago. Stocks held by domestic bleachers at the end of August were withheld to avoid disclosing data for individual companies. Oil mill stocks totaled 9,000 bales at the end of August.

Cottonseed receipts at oil mills totaled 120,000 tons through August this season compared with 98,000 tons a year earlier and 89,000 tons two years ago. Oil mills crushed 194,000 tons of cottonseed during August, compared with 139,000 in the previous year and 195,000 two years ago. Oil mills had 347,000 tons of cottonseed on hand at the end of August compared to 306,000 tons a year ago and 294,000 at the end of August 2002.

United States exports of raw cotton linters totaled 1,929 metric tons during August, compared to 1,190 tons last year and 2,507 tons two years ago.
