



13A. Exhibit A

Origin and Breeding History of the Variety

1. The variety SCORE has been derived from plants collected in the northern part of the Netherlands in 1969.
  2. Seed was harvested from clonal plots in 1970 and 1971. This seed was sown late 1972 in the greenhouse to determinate on individual plants the homogeneity of the clones, date of shooting and vegetative development as compared with other varieties during 1973 and 1974. In 1973 SCORE was established on 5 clones.
  3. The homogeneity, based on observations on single plants of the clonal seed, was very good. It was observed that this homogeneity was better than in existing commercial varieties such as Manhattan, Pennfine or S 23. This especially in connection with shooting date and type of plants.
  4. From the clonal stage till the third generation (breeder seed) there are no remarks about instability. The average shooting dates of the clonal seed plants and of the breeder seed plants are quite similar.



13B. Exhibit B

Botanical description of the Variety

1. During the whole growing period from the seedling stage till the mature plant SCORE gives a much more lighter foliage than Manhattan and Sprinter. The leafwidth is about similar to Sprinter and Manhattan, but the flag leaves are a little longer than and not as sturdy as those of Sprinter and Manhattan.

2. The ears of SCORE are somewhat longer than those of Manhattan and Sprinter.

The type of plant is not quite as flat as Manhattan and Sprinter.

The density of the plant is better than that of Manhattan, but not quite as good as that of Sprinter.
