



The Shell Egg Demand Indicator for this week is -11.00, down 0.2 points from last week.

This Week:

Shell egg demand remains about unchanged. While the supply situation has become stable, retail prices have been slow to adjust which is helping to dampen demand. Wholesale prices for negotiated trading of loose caged eggs are higher with light to moderate demand and offerings. Supplies are moderate and trading is moderate. Wholesale prices for formula trading of carton stock are steady after increasing slightly early in the week on light to moderate demand. Wholesale breaking stock prices are unchanged with moderate demand for light to moderate offerings. Supplies are light to moderate with mixed schedules and moderate trading. The preliminary survey of retail outlets indicates a slight slowdown in the pace of feature activity from last week for shell eggs with an increase in the average ad price.

Current Table Egg Production for In-Shell Use -

(shell egg production less shell eggs for breaking stock)

Table with 3 rows: Table egg layer rate (82.2%), Total egg production (226,922,481), Total eggs into breaking stock (75,663,823), Table eggs for in-shell use (151,258,658), Table eggs for in-shell use (in cases) (420,163).

Current Days of Shell Eggs on Hand for Marketing -

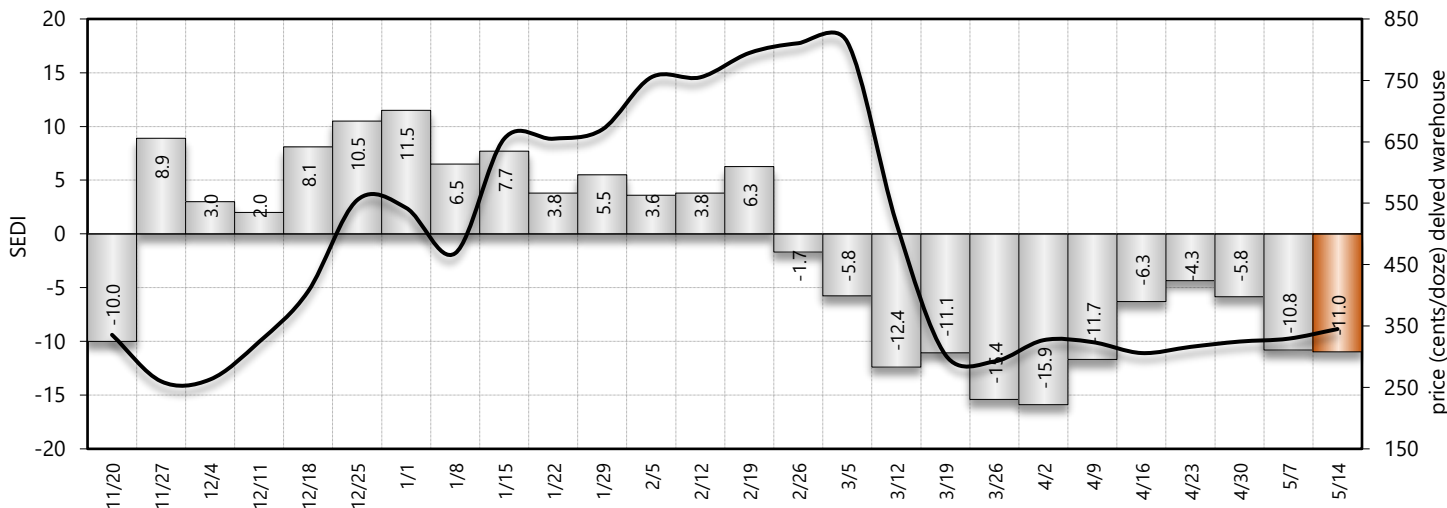
(shell egg inventory cases ÷ shell egg cases per day)
