CALIFORNIA DELIVERED MARKETS
Seven-Day Reporting Period Ending Thursday, May 17, 2012
 (Unless otherwise stated, all prices per cwt)

TRENDS: Kansas City July wheat futures ended the reporting week on Thursday, May 17, at 6.72, 39 cents per bushel higher than last Thursday's July close of 6.33. Chicago July corn futures closed at 6.25, 10-1/2 cents per bushel higher than last Thursday's July close of 6.14-1/2.

BARLEY: Trading of barley was slow during the week and not well tested.

CORN: Offers for corn rail delivered to Los Angeles and the Chino Valley advanced by 67 cents per cwt compared to week ago offers in response to the higher Chicago July corn futures. Offers for corn truck delivered to the Modesto-Oakdale-Turlock areas were 58 to 72 cents higher, also supported by the higher Chicago July futures.

OATS: Oats offers for delivery to Los Angeles remained steady with last week's levels.

WHEAT: Bids for nearby delivered California origin, 13.0 percent protein milling wheat at Los Angeles, were not quoted due to extremely limited supplies. The bases for out of state origin, 11 to 12 percent protein hard red winter wheat, were 2.00 to 2.10 over the Kansas City July wheat futures, and the bases for out of state origin 13.0 percent protein ranged from 2.20 to 2.50 per bushel over the Kansas City July wheat futures.

CALIFORNIA CROP WEATHER FOR THE WEEK ENDING May 13, 2012: Warm and dry conditions this week aided the maturation progress for the wheat crop. The whole crop was virtually headed as harvest started throughout the State. Some early planted wheat was cut for hay and silage as conditions continued to be rated mostly good to excellent. Oat hay cutting continued. Alfalfa growers advanced to the second cutting in the Central Valley while some producers were treating their crop for alfalfa weevil. Warmer soil temperatures were benefitting cotton as producers were nearly finished planting the crop as the early planted cotton was emerging at a rapid pace. Corn showed good development. Rice plantings continued.
