Under the Proposed National Organic Rule, I find the labeling as "organic" of food produced with the use of Genetically Modified Organisms (GMOs), municipal sludge (for fertilizer), or irradiation totally unacceptable. I do not want the label "ORGANIC" to be made meaningless by standards and criteria for this label set forth in the proposed National Organic Rule published for public view on December 16, 1997.

I am requesting that the recommendations of the organic farmers and other appropriate representatives on the NATIONAL ORGANIC STANDARDS BOARD be followed. Since they have been rejected, we might as well not have the Proposed National Organic rule created by the USDA.
