

## **CROPS COMMITTEE: MATERIALS MOTIONS (Presented May 7, 2002)**

### **Calcium Oxide**

Calcium Oxide is a synthetic material which should be added to the National List with the following annotations:

- a. Must be a source from lime kilns.
- b. To be used only when documented soil tests indicate sufficient or excess magnesium
- c. To be applied in a form that yields less than a one degree Fahrenheit temperature increase when equal volumes of the product and water are mixed.

### **Calcium Oxide (Hydroxide)**

Calcium Oxide is a synthetic material which should be added to the National list with the following annotations:

- a. Must be a source from lime kilns.
- b. To be used only when documented soil tests indicate sufficient or excess magnesium
- c. To be applied in a form that yields less than a one degree Fahrenheit temperature increase when equal volumes of the product and water are mixed.

### **Potassium Sorbate**

Potassium sorbate is a synthetic material that should not be added to the National List.

### **Sodium Propionate**

Sodium propionate is a synthetic material that should not be added to the National List.

### **Sodium Nitrate**

Postpone consideration of the two petitions involving sodium nitrate until the September NOSB meeting.

### **Spinsoad**

Spinsoad is a nonsynthetic material that should not be added to the National List.
