**COMMODITY SPECIFICATION FOR
TURKEY AND TURKEY PRODUCTS
DATED APRIL 1999**

Amendment No. 1

This amendment revises the number of packaged turkey roasts to be sampled and examined for compliance for fabrication, size, and grade factors.

1. Change the first sentence in Section II.E.13.a. on page 12 to read as follows:

“a. Examination for fabrication. Three packaged roasts will be sampled and examined for compliance with fabrication defects (requirements for meat and skin percentages, II.E.7.) as shown in Table 2 below.”

2. Change the first sentence in Section II.E.13.b.(1) on page 12 to read as follows:

“(1) Three roasts will be examined for the defects shown in Table 2 below.”

EFFECTIVE DATE: This amendment is effective with offers due by 1p.m., Washington, D.C., time, Monday August 7, 2000, and on all subsequent offers. The words, “and Amendment No. 1,” must be inserted after “the Commodity Specification dated April 1999” in item 1 of each offer.

All other terms and conditions of the Commodity Specification for Turkey and Turkey Products dated April 1999 remain unchanged.
