BASED ON THE PRELIMINARY CHICK PLACEMENTS, THE NUMBER OF FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING DURING THE WEEK ENDING 29-Dec-01 IS ESTIMATED AT 138.0 MILLION HEAD. THIS COMPARES TO 142.8 MILLION HEAD THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND TO 141.3 MILLION HEAD THE SAME WEEK A YEAR AGO, WHEN THE SLAUGHTER WAS 117.9 MILLION HEAD AND THE 12-CITY WEIGHTED AVERAGE PRICE WAS 56.21 CENTS PER POUND.






New York Large Egg Weekly Average Price 1999, 2000, 2001
