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

## NATIONAL EGG REVIEW



Early week prices were higher on all sizes. During the week prices were unchanged with mediums higher in some locations. The market tone was mostly steady. Demand was in a full range light to good, but was usually moderate to good in most locations. Supplies were generally adequate for trade needs. Central States breaking stock prices were unchanged with checks and undergrades higher. Offerings were usually adequate to available. Demand was moderate to good with reports of gradeable shell eggs beginning to be offered into breaking channels. Most breakers were working through existing inventories and calculating needs going into the approaching 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday. Floor stocks adequate to in close balance. Schedules mixed. Trade sentiment steady. Offerings for light type fowl were fully adequate to mostly ample for the moderate demand.




### New York Large Weekly Average Price

Cents per Dozen




### Chicago Broiler/Fryer Weighted Average Prices
