## NATIONAL EGG REVIEW



At the beginning and during the week prices were unchanged in most locations. The market tone was steady to fully steady. Demand was light to fairly good with features providing the best interest. Supplies were fully adequate to closely balanced and were being held with more confidence. The nest run breaking stock prices were higher with checks and undergrades prices unchanged. Offerings were tight with demand continuing fairly good to good. Most potential buyers of heavy nest runs were finding considerable difficulty in both current and future bookings. Floor stocks in close balance to short. Schedules mostly full-time. Trade sentiment steady to fully steady.

PRICES TO RETAILERS, SALES TO VOLUME BUYERS, USDA GRADE A AND GRADE A, WHITE EGGS IN CARTONS, DELIVERED WAREHOUSE, CENTS PER DOZEN.

**MIDWEST REGIONAL** Prices unchanged. Trade sentiment was fully steady. Retail demand was moderate to fairly good. Food service movement was moderate to good. Supplies were adequate to close due to high hen flock removal and were being held with increased confidence. Central states breaking stock prices were unchanged. Offerings were tight to very tight with demand continuing fairly good to good. Most potential buyers of heavy nest runs were finding considerable difficulty in both current and future bookings. Floor stocks in close balance to short. Schedules mostly full-time. Trade sentiment steady to fully steady.






