## NATIONAL EGG REVIEW



At the beginning of the week prices were higher on all sizes in all locations. As the week progressed prices in all locations were higher. In Chicago and New York, prices were higher on all sizes. Trade sentiment was fully steady to firm. Demand into all outlets ranged light to very good. Supplies were adequate to tight with the heavier weights in the best position. Nest run breaking stock prices were higher. Offerings were about adequate to tight as demand continued fairly good to good while any available breaking stock was readily absorbed at the quoted mostly price. Floor stocks were balanced to about adequate. Trade sentiment was fully steady. Liquid offerings were reported as short for whites and tight on the balance of products. Offerings for light type fowl were fully adequate to mostly ample.

PRICES TO RETAILERS, SALES TO VOLUME BUYERS, USDA GRADE A AND GRADE A, WHITE EGGS IN CARTONS, DELIVERED WAREHOUSE, CENTS PER DOZEN.

**MIDWEST REGIONAL** Prices unchanged. Trade sentiment was fully steady to firm. Retail demand was moderate to usually very good. Food service movement was moderate to good. Supplies were adequate to close with the larger sizes in the tightest position. Central states breaking stock prices were 1 cent higher. Offerings were about adequate to tight as demand continued fairly good to good while any available breaking stock was readily absorbed at the quoted mostly. Floor stocks balanced to about adequate. Trade sentiment fully steady.

Light type fowl were fully adequate for the light to no better than fair demand.

**Broiler/Fryer: Weekly Fryers Available for Marketing** Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for the marketing during the week ending 20-Sep-03 is estimated at 155.2 million head. This compares to 154.1 million head the previous week and to 159.0 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 162.7 million head and the composite weighted average price was 56.69 cents per pound.






New York Large Weekly Average Price
