NATIONAL LIQUID Pasteurized salt yolk reported from 43 to 48 cents fob with no pasteurized whites reported. Trade sentiment continued steady for whole egg, weak for whites, while yolk was reported as steady with a firm undertone. Demand was good for whole egg and yolk with demand for whites slowing somewhat with spot availability noted. Offerings were generally adequate for whole egg, just adequate to tight for yolk and adequate to fully adequate for whites. Breaking stock prices were unchanged to 2 cents lower when compared to the previous week's reported prices.

Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending 12 June 2004 were 3% less than the previous week, and unchanged when compared to a year ago.

NATIONAL DRIED EGG Majority prices were unchanged on yolks, unchanged to slightly lower on whole, slightly lower on blends and lower on albumen when compared to a week earlier. Demand was light to good, with most buyers continue to watch further market developments especially on albumen. Overall, trade sentiment was at least fully steady to occasionally firm on yolks, steady on whole, and unsettled to mostly weak on albumen. Dried eggs processed under federal inspection for the week ending 12 June 2004 were 1% more than the previous week, and 30% more than a year ago. The total year to date dried eggs produced were 20% higher than a year earlier.
