

### DOMESTIC MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

The market tone was steady to fully steady for hens and toms. Limited trading reported for prompt and deferred. Demand remains mixed with some interest noted for the Thanksgiving holiday period. Supplies mixed. Offerings are light to adequate and held with confidence. Parts and meats trading was slow. Demand light.



### EXPORT MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

Demand light to moderate. Trading generally slow with limited sales centered on frozen thigh meat.

**NATIONAL YOUNG TURKEY PARTS AND BULK MEAT**, FROZEN (UNLESS SPECIFIED), CENTS PER LB., DELIVERED FIRST RECEIVERS, PART AND FULL TRUCKLOTS AS OF 10 JUNE 2002.

The undertone was steady to fully steady on fresh tom breast meat and fresh destrapped tenderloins. Demand was light to mostly moderate. Offerings were tight to sometimes adequate. The undertone on beast trim, scapula and fresh wing meat was about steady for the light to generally adequate supplies. The undertone on frozen wing meat with skin was barely steady at best for the slow demand and adequate to ample offerings. Trading centered on a moderate volume of fresh mechanically separated turkey for domestic shipments and on a light volume of frozen thigh meat for export. On June 7, 2002, USDA announced the Deli-Style Turkey Breast Purchase Program. Offers are due by 12 noon, Central Time, June 24 with product to be delivered from August 1 - 15, 2002.
