

NOTICE TO THE DAIRY INDUSTRY

FDA Announces an Electronic System for Milk Products Export Lists

As announced on July 25, 2016, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) launched a new electronic system to facilitate applications for U.S. manufacturers and processors of milk products to be included on lists of firms eligible to export to facilitate meeting a foreign country's requirements. Some foreign countries use a list to identify U.S. manufacturers and processors that are eligible to ship dairy products to their countries. To help U.S. exporters that are interested in exporting dairy products to these countries, FDA has established and currently maintains country-specific lists for dairy products for China, Chile, and the European Union.

FDA is encouraging firms to use the new electronic system to apply for inclusion on the applicable lists. Firms may do so via the <u>FDA Unified Registration and Listing Systems</u> (FURLS) Dairy Listing Module (DLM).
