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



REVIEW OF THE BURLEY TOBACCO MARKETS
1971-72 SEASON

Average price highest in Burley history
All grade averages reached record levels
One of the first-rate quality Burley crops
Sales volume below quota allowed under
new poundage-quota program.

From a quality standpoint, the 1971 crop should be ranked among the best of the Burley crops. The overall average price paid for the crop was the highest ever recorded and all individual grade averages were up substantially over last season's record levels. Because of much smaller acreage yields, the crop was the smallest in thirteen years, but due to the record high prices the return was still a respectable \$380 million. The loan take was less than one-tenth of one percent -- the smallest in Burley history.

The Agricultural Marketing Service (formerly the Consumer and Marketing Service) of the United States Department of Agriculture reported a net average price of \$80.88 per hundred pounds paid for the 1971 Burley crop -- up \$8.75 over the 1970 average of \$72.13 and topping the old record of \$73.67 set in 1968 by \$7.21. Net 1/ sales totaled 470.7 million pounds (including about 11.6 million pounds of non-auction * sales) -- down about 80.4 million from the preceding season. The crop was valued at \$380.7 million -- a decline of \$16.8 million from a year ago.

The Burley marketing season opened on November 22, 1971 and sales ended on February 10, 1972 with a clean-up sale at Lexington, Kentucky. The maximum number of sales days was 35 compared to 33 a year ago. See table 1 on pages 7-8 for closing dates of individual markets. About 81 percent of the crop was sold before the Christmas holiday recess.

Deliveries of the 1971 crop to the Burley Associations under the Government loan program totaled only 178,000 pounds--less than one-tenth of one percent and was the smallest poundage ever turned over to the Cooperatives. In the preceding season 47.7 million pounds or 8.5 percent of the net sales went under loan. See table 4 on page 13 for information on loan takes for preceding crops.

1/ All known marketings by producers. This figure may vary from estimates of the Crop Reporting Board, SRS, as the Board includes all tobacco produced during the current year regardless of when sold.

Grade prices. Prices for all grades were substantially higher than last seasons record levels. About three-fourths of the averages were \$4 to \$12 higher per 100 pounds and the remainder \$13 to \$17 over last season's prices. Leaf grades and tips showed the largest gains and flyings and lugs the smallest. Most grades of better lugs and flyings sold for \$3 to \$4 above their respective support levels while some nondescript and many lower grades of leaf and tips topped their support levels by as much as \$20 to \$27 per 100 pounds. See table 13 on pages 27-28 for individual grade price comparisons.

Composition of offerings. This was a small but high quality crop consisting of larger proportions of choice, fine and good tobacco and less of the low grades and nondescript. More buff, tan and tanish red and not as much variegated, green and greenish tobacco was marketed. Most of the offerings consisted of fair to fine leaf, low to good lugs and fair to good flyings. See table 14 on page 29 to compare the current crop with crops of past years.

The average loan level on the 1971 Burley crop was 71.5 cents per pound -- up about 4.2 percent over the 1970 level of 68.6 cents. Rates by grades ranged from 44 cents per pound for N2G and N2R to 80 cents for C1L,C1F,X1L and X1F. The 1972 Burley crop will be supported at 74.9 cents per pound -- an increase of about 4.8 percent over the 1971 level.

Regulations governing marketing operations were about the same as those in effect for past seasons. Sales were conducted for 3½ hours per day at the rate of 360 baskets per hour with ware housemen having the option of operating on a basket or a poundage basis. Those choosing the poundage option were limited to 340,200 pounds per day per set of buyers provided they did not exceed 1,800 baskets.

. Inspection and market news. Federal inspection and market news service, in effect on all markets, provide the grower with information as to the quality of his tobacco according to Federal grades and to the current average price at which such grades are selling. (All baskets of tobacco are inspected and graded by Government officials prior to sales, and price reports are made available to growers on the auction floors). The program, operated under the authority of the Tobacco Inspection Act,(approved on August 23, 1935) offers free and mandatory inspection on auction markets designated by the Secretary of Agriculture for such service following favorable referendums of growers selling on such markets.

The level of price support is determined by the following method: The 1969 price support level is used as a base figure and adjusted each year in accordance with the change between the 1959 parity index(index of prices and wage rates) and the parity index for the three years just preceding the year for which the level is being determined. The 1971 level of 71.5 cents per pound was arrived at by applying to the 1959 level the percentage comparison between (1) the 1959 parity index and (2) the parity index of the three year period 1968-1970 (57.2×125 equals 71.5).

Under the new program, based on poundage only (approved May 4, 1971) and in effect for the 1971 Burley marketing season, farmers who certified that they had not used pesticides containing DDT and TDE on their tobacco could market up to 110 percent of their farm poundage quotas backed by U.S. Government support. However, any marketings over the farm's poundage quota must be subtracted from the next year's quota. This program will be in effect for the 1972 and 1973 crops as well. Burley tobacco crops have been consecutively supported by some form of U.S. Government support since 1939.


