




## 1983 Season



Flue-cured auction markets were grouped into broad marketing areas by the Flue-Cured Tobacco Advisory Committee. Buyers and inspectors were assigned to marketing areas based on designations by growers.

## Review of the 1983 Marketing Season

Producers experienced very unfavorable weather conditions during much of the 1983 growing season. Cool, wet weather in the spring delayed field preparation and planting. This was followed by excessive heat and drought conditions during the summer. The result was light crops with a high percentage of unripe or immature colors. This, coupled with a relatively light demand, contributed to substantial amounts of tobacco being placed under loan. Producers' sales were limited to 80 million pounds per week again this season. The Stabilization Corporation offered for sale in July the 1982 carryover tobacco. Grade standards were changed by adding new grades and deleting some no longer needed to accurately describe the tobacco on floors.

**Sales and averages.** Producers received an average price of \$177.82 per hundred for the 1983 crop--a decrease of 72 cents from 1982. Net sales at auction of 814.7 million pounds were down 17.5 percent from 1982 and represented the smallest crop since 1943. Net value of \$1,448.7 million declined 17.8 percent from last season and was 23.9 percent below the record value of \$1,899.9 million received for the 1981 crop.

**Grade averages.** With the loan rate frozen at the 1982 level, individual grade averages did not show strong increases this season. In fact, losses were recorded for primings and nondescript tobacco. Leaf and smoking leaf grades were unchanged to \$10 per hundred higher, mostly \$2 to \$8 higher. Cutters were unchanged to \$4 higher, mostly up \$2 to \$4, while most lugs gained \$1 to \$3 per hundred from a year ago. Primings declined mostly \$3 to \$6 and nondescript grades were down \$5 to \$17 per hundred. The practical top price for 1983 was considered to be \$205, unchanged from the 1982 figure.

**Composition of offerings.** Overall quality was not as good as for the 1982 crop, as the hot, dry weather during the late growing season hit some belts hard. Increases were recorded in low and poor quality categories as well as in unripe and immature colors. Tobacco grading good quality or better slipped to 13 percent of auctions, fair quality was down to 54 percent, low and poor quality increased to 24 and 4 percent respectively. Offerings considered mature to mellow declined to 41 percent of sales while unripe and immature combined for 55 percent. Percentages by group were: leaf 57; cutters 11; lugs 17; primings 10; nondescript 4; others accounted for 1 percent of auctions. The three heaviest volume grades and their percentages were: B4KM (8.7); B4KF (7.0); and B5KF (5.0). Rounding out the top ten grades were: B4K (4.9); C4KM (4.2); B5K (4.0); P4F (3.1); B3KM (2.9); X4KM (2.9); and B5KM (2.4). These ten grades made up 45.1 percent of all flue-cured sales in 1983.

**Loan rates.** Loan rates by grades for the 1983 crop reflected an average support level of \$1.699 per pound, unchanged from the 1982 figure.

**Stabilization receipts.** Less tobacco was received by the Flue-Cured Stabilization Corporation in 1983. A total of 162.5 million pounds at auction, representing 19.9 percent of net sales, was delivered to the Cooperative. This does not include 30.9 million pounds placed under loan from the 1982 carryover tobacco. This compares to 258.9 million pounds placed under loan from the 1982 auctions. Percentages of auction loan receipts by group follow:

**New grades.** The Official Standard Grades were revised for the 1983 crop in order to more accurately describe tobacco on floors. Nine new grades were added. They were: C5LP; C5FP; C4LL; X4LL; B4KD; B5KD; B6KD; X4S; and C4KF. Also, ten grades were deleted. They were: B4R; H1F; H2F; M4F; M5F; M4KR; M4KM; M5KM; M4GK; and M5GK. For details, see page 5 of this review.

**Marketing regulations.** Auctions continued to be controlled by the grower designation plan that was implemented for the 1974 season. In 1983, a user fee of 55 cents per hundred was charged for grading services of the Tobacco Division, USDA. The assessment to the grower for the "no-net-cost tobacco account" was raised from 3 cents per pound to 7 cents per pound. Also, owners of flue-cured quotas who leased and transferred all or any part of a marketing quota were required to contribute to the "no-net-cost" fund an amount equal to the producers' contribution--7 cents per pound of quota transferred in 1983. In addition, producers who marketed tobacco ineligible for price support because they did not agree to contribute to the fund, were subject to a penalty of 75 percent of the previous year's average market price. The Stabilization Corporation's deduction for overhead cost remained at 1 cent per pound. A referendum was held December 16, 1982, to approve marketing quotas for the 1983-85 crops of flue-cured tobacco. It was approved with 93.7 percent voting in favor.

**1982 Carryover sales.** The Flue-Cured Stabilization Corporation offered the 37.2 million pounds of 1982 carryover tobacco for sale on a sealed bid basis in July 1983. They sold 6.3 million pounds with the remaining 30.9 million placed under loan. This 37.2 million pounds counted against the 1983 effective quota, and the amount placed under loan will be shown in Stabilization Corporation's records as 1983 crop tobacco. However, tables in this review do not reflect these sales and loan receipts, but show only what was marketed at auction during the 1983 season.

**Preliminary 1984 quota.** The basic quota for 1984 was reduced to 805 million pounds (11.5 percent reduction). Due to net undermarketings, the 1984 effective quota is projected at 840 million pounds, 52 million below the 1983 effective figure of 892 million pounds.
