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2) The following paragraph under Section C.18.b Food Safety and Inspection Requirements on page 23 is deleted:

"Facilities used in fulfilling USDA contracts must be operating under the provisions of the Voluntary Exotic Animal Inspection Program of the FSIS contained in Title 9 C.F.R. Subpart 352.
