Direct Hay Weighted Average Report for week ending 5/16/2025

Compared to the last report: Trade activity and demand were moderate. Retail hay demand was good. Dairy hay demand was steady. Export hay demand was light. In the North San Joaquin Valley, low-potassium hay was reported at \$230/ton. Throughout the state of California, production costs (fuel, fertilizer, parts, energy) have gone up. According to the US Drought Monitor, average temperatures were above normal across nearly the entire region this week, while below-normal temperatures were observed across much of New Mexico, and in parts of Arizona and along the coast of Washington, Oregon, and California, where temperatures were between 1 to 6 degrees F below normal. The next available hay report will be May 23, 2025.
