Direct Hay Weighted Average Report for week ending 5/16/2025

Several producers finally got to the hay fields this week, baling Alfalfa and getting some wheat, rye or the like wrapped. Those that produce some grain crops made good progress planting if they hadn't already gotten crops in. Pasture conditions across the state are mostly good to excellent. Although pastures are lush and green there is beginning to be some concern especially in the Northern third of the state as the area showing on the drought monitor slowly grows each week. Twenty-two percent of the state is currently listed with some areas creeping into D1 status now. Currently most hay demand is coming from equine interest. Hay prices are steady, supply and demand are light to moderate.
