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Direct Hay Weighted Average Report for week ending 5/16/2025

Compared to the last report, there is still light demand even though movement has increased this week. Large sales were made with some producers that are trying to empty out their barns for new crop. New crop has started getting cut in Western Idaho but got stopped this past week due to rain.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor Website, Central Idaho, Northern Idaho, and Northeast Idaho are in abnormally dry to moderate dry, with the rest of Idaho under normal soil moisture. According to the Idaho Crop Progress Report, as of May 11th, alfalfa hay 1st cutting is 1% completed in the state, pasture and range is 36% good condition, winter wheat is 61% good condition, spring wheat is 64% good condition, winter canola is 61% good condition, 60% field corn has been planted.
