Compared to last week hay market is steady with 2nd cuttings are underway. According to National Agricultural statistics Services as of April 20, 2025. Alfalfa hay harvest continued to take place on about 55 percent of the crop's acreage throughout the State. Arizona's alfalfa crop was rated in mostly good to excellent condition, with only 11 percent of the crop rated fair. According to U.S. Drought Monitor as of April 22, 2025. Along the southern tier of the region, expansion of the broad-scale severe to extreme drought was noted in parts of New Mexico, southern Utah, and adjacent Arizona. The most intense levels of drought (D3 and D4) now cover a broad area from southeastern California, southern Nevada, and southwestern Utah through much of Arizona, southern and western New Mexico, and the Texas Big Bend into south-central parts of the state.
