The Central and East dry buttermilk price series was unchanged this week. Cream remains abundant in both the Central and East regions. Butter plant managers in both regions relay robust churning schedules and share they are freezing large amounts of bulk butter. Condensed buttermilk supplies are steady compared to recent weeks, but drying activity continues to increase. While dry buttermilk inventories are growing, though, so too has demand. Some contacts report being out of stock for the near term and having to turn customers away. Contacts anticipate steady demand leading into the spring holiday season.
