Compared to last week in the Southern Plains live FOB purchases traded 2.00 higher at 185.00, on a light test. The most recent market in Nebraska was Thursday with live FOB purchases traded from 185.00-186.00, mostly at 185.00, with dressed delivered purchases traded from 292.00-300.00. The most recent market in the Western Cornbelt was Thursday with live FOB purchases from 185.00 - 186.00, dressed delivered purchases traded at 292.00.
