Next available report will be Thursday, November 7, 2024. Supply included: 18% Feeder Cattle (60% Heifers, 40% Dairy Heifers); 76% Slaughter Cattle (92% Cows, 8% Bulls); 5% Replacement Cattle (100% Bred Cows). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 100%.
