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## Direct Hay Weighted Average Report for week ending 5/9/2025

Movement this past week has been inactive with no new hay sales besides cubes being delivered regularly. Supply is lower in the state this week with people starting to look for hay out of state. According to the drought monitor website, Utah is mostly under moderate to severe dry soil moisture, a small part of southwest Utah is under extreme dry soil moisture. Northeastern and Northern Utah is under abnormally dry soil moisture. According to the Utah Crop Progress Report, as of May 4th, Hay and roughage supplies were rated 65% adequate. Alfalfa hay is 65% good condition, other hay is 76% good condition, pasture and range is 54% good condition, winter wheat is 70% good condition, corn is 12% planted this week.
