

TEXAS WEEKLY SUMMARY

Week Ending August 19, 2017

Receipts: This Week 18,375 Last Report 17,931 Year Ago 19,750

Feeder steers and heifers sold steady to 3.00 lower. Trade activity was slow to moderate on moderate demand. Rainfall across the trading area hampered cattle movement paired with struggling CME cattle futures. Slaughter cows and bulls 3.00-4.00 lower. Trade fairly active. Demand fairly good. All hay classes remained mostly steady on slow movement. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were 2 to 4 cents higher on grain sorghum; unchanged to 1 cent higher on wheat; and mostly 1 to 6 cents higher on corn.

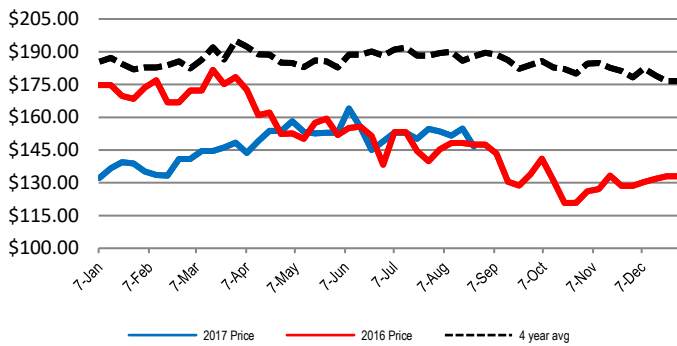

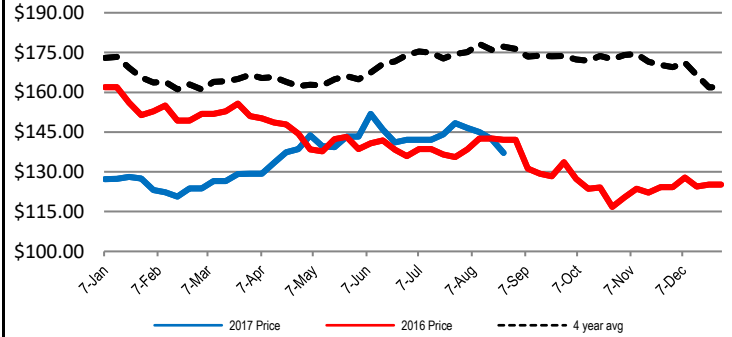
