

TEXAS WEEKLY SUMMARY

Week Ending October 13, 2018

Receipts: This Week 15,500 Last Week: 30,600 Year Ago 26,900

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold mostly steady to weak, except for conditioned yearlings sold steady to instances 4.00 higher. Trade activity was light to moderate on moderate demand. The trading area received a substantial amount of rainfall making for muddy conditions but benefitted local wheat pastures. Slaughter cows steady; slaughter bulls not well tested. All hay classes traded fully steady. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were mostly 8 to 9 cents higher on grain sorghum; 10 to 12 cents higher on wheat; mostly 4 to 5 cents higher on corn.

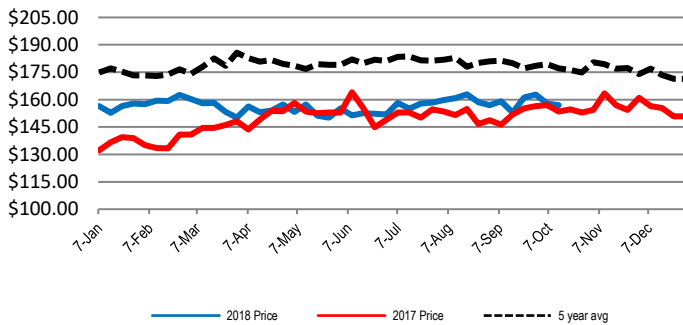

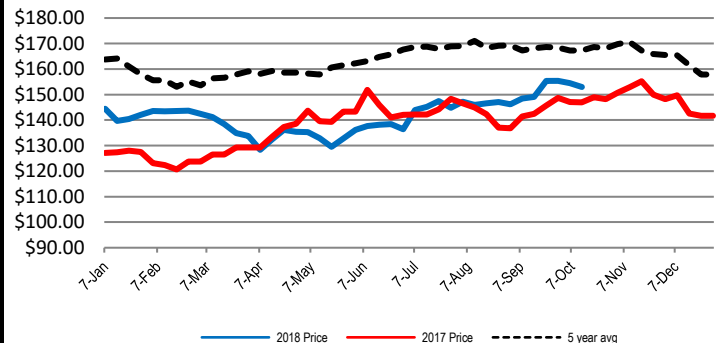
WEEKLY 600 LB STEER PRICE M&L 1, 1-2, 2
